This multi-disciplinary university of Literature, Arts, Languages, Human and Social Sciences, is named after Paul Valéry, the renowned writer from Sète, who studied in Montpellier.

> The University of Montpellier was founded in 1289, the third in France after Paris and Toulouse. In 1970, the former Law, Sciences and Literature faculties, were divided into three separate universities, one of which is Paul-Valéry Montpellier 3 (UPVM3).

> UPVM3 has 5 teaching and research sites in Montpellier (Route de Mende, St-Charles, St-Louis) and Béziers (Centre Du-Guesclin), plus a temporary site (Boutonnet), as well as the Université du Tiers-Temps (UTT) located in the historic heart of Montpellier.

> ▶ The Route de Mende campus, which was awarded a '20th century heritage' label, was built in 1966. It is linked to the centre of Montpellier in less than half an hour by tram or bicycle. UPVM3 offers a stimulating setting with Mediterranean vegetation and numerous works of art lining this beautiful, wooded area to the north of the city. It is constantly evolving and many projects are currently underway to accompany its fundamental and longterm transformation. Several have already been completed, and others are ongoing, notably ATRIUM, the "Learning Center" which will open in 2023, with its bold architecture heralding new learning environments.

> The Saint-Charles site, renovated and modernised, is the university's research showcase, directly open to the city.

The site houses 21 interdisciplinary research teams, including 5 mixed units plus the Human Sciences unit, the Francophone unit, a library, an auditorium, conference rooms, a cafeteria, green spaces and courtyards... all treated in a highly contemporary spirit.

Since 2016, the University has integrated a sustainable development and societal responsibility programme and is the only university in the Occitanie Region to be labelled DD&RS (Sustainable Development and Social Responsibility) to date.

ATRIUM: A NEW GENERATION OF LIBRARIES

The 15,000 m² ATRIUM project will house a library inspired by the most innovative models, both in terms of its architectural uniqueness and the wealth of its printed and electronic collections.

Academic and external users will have access to over 600,000 printed documents and thousands of digital resources, rare and original document collections, multiple technological services, inviting work rooms as well as a cafeteria and relaxation areas.

NEXUS: THE 'NEW CURRICULA' OF DIGITAL HUMANITIES

Winner of the "Programme of investment for the future" (PIA) – "Nexus: success at Licence level with digital humanities".

► La Fabrique is the future building linked to the "Nexus" educational project. The building, more than 90% of which is financed by the Occitanie Region, will offer over 2.500m² to house all activities related to cross-disciplinary computer science courses.

This building will promote collaboration and digital innovation for the Humanities:

production of training modules in Digital Humanities;

 development of partnership projects in training/research in Digital Humanities;

coordination with the practical demands of the socio-economic sector;

provision of connected research zones, for collaborative projects with presentation of lecturer-researcher and student production.

Focused on the Arts, Literature, Languages, Social and Human Sciences, Paul-Valéry University offers an attractive range of artistic and cultural training options. Culture is the very substance of our institution, it forms an integral part of all our social and educational missions, training, research and societal contributions.

The campus benefits from exceptional facilities: a Museum of Mouldings, La Vignette, a national theatre eligible for public funding, a symphony orchestra linked to the Montpellier Méditerranée Métropole Regional Conservatory, and an International Centre for Medieval Music.

THE CAMPUS, A HUB OF CULTURE AND INNOVATION

Our university holds the "20th century heritage" label. The original architecture, Characteristic of the 1970s, stands alongside contemporary buildings.

▶ With a "20th century heritage" label, awarded by the Minister of Culture and Communication, the University's original buildings are protected as historical monuments, representative of 20th century creation.

THE CAMPUS IS BEING RENOVATED AND EXPANDED

THE ATRIUM stands at the entrance to the campus. Its audacious design symbolises the University's forward looking approach. More than just a university library, the future "Learning Center" is an innovative concept with cutting edge services and facilities.

Nexus, a major university and scientific project, will be completed in 2026 with a dedicated digital building, "La Fabrique".

In 2025, the current "Ramon Llull" university library, which holds a "20th century heritage" label, will be equipped with new classrooms and auditoriums, academic and scientific documentation centres (CDPS), and shared facilities, including an exhibition hall and cafeteria...
